Durham CBN, along with Hartlepool CBN, Sunderland CBN, Gateshead CBN and Stockton on Tees CBN have been successful in attracting a range of funding sources to deliver a number of exciting community coaching programmes across the North East.

At this exciting time we are inviting suitably qualified and experienced Coaches to submit a proposal to undertake this contract on a self employed basis, based within education and community environments. This contract encompasses coaching delivery for a number of partners and organisations and provides an opportunity for a qualified and experienced coach to operate across the North East region, delivering local coaching needs based on the contracts already secured.

In the North East region, the successful Coach will need to:

- Be motivated and driven towards providing high quality experiences
- Be able to work independently
- Have an engaging personality
- Be adaptable to delivering coaching for various community and education groups
- Be a suitably qualified coach

The self employed contract issued to the successful Coach will include the requirement to deliver various coaching contracts, including administration for monitoring the progress of projects. The coaching delivery will also require some evening work and occasional weekend work.

The contract is being offered to the successful candidate with a contract fee of £16,000 to deliver a total of 700 hours over a period of 12 months

Interested Coaches are invited to submit a proposal, which should include a CV, outlining how they meet the requirements of the assignment detailed within the attached schedule of services and role specification.

Schedule of Services North East Regional Badminton Coach (self employed)

Location:

Delivery will be across various locations in the North East; Stockton on Tees, Hartlepool, Durham City, Gateshead and Sunderland in education environments and community environments.

Terms:

- i. The post will be on a self employed basis and a self employed contract will be issued by Durham City Community Badminton Network, in partnership with Hartlepool Community Badminton Network, Gateshead Community Badminton Network, Stockton on Tees Community Badminton Network, Sunderland Community Badminton Network and Durham County Badminton Association.
- ii. 700 hours over a 12 month period from the date of the contract being awarded
- iii. Coaching delivery will include some evening work and occasional weekend work
- iv. The self employed coach will be expected to provide appropriate substitution for sessions when absent
- v. No additional fees will be offered for travel time and mileage

Requirements:

- i. Durham Swifts School Delivery (150 hours)
 - a. Delivery in cluster schools of Durham City, within curriculum time both primary, secondary and sixth forms
- ii. Badminton for Better Health in Hartlepool (190 hours)
 - a. 6 hours a week of adult sessions in the community with partners such as Age UK, Parkinson's UK and MIND
- iii. Durham County Badminton Association (72 hours)
 - a. Delivery of junior squads on a fortnightly basis
- iv. Delivery and monitoring of junior and senior projects across the five CBN areas in the North East (288 hours)
- v. Attend periodic review meetings with funding leads and nominated member of the 5 Community Badminton Networks
- vi. Be responsible for the coordination, delivery and monitoring of the above contracts within agreed time frames
- vii. To provide equipment as needed for each project

Contract Fee:

A total contract fee of £16,000 will be paid to the successful Coach to fulfil the above requirements and shall be paid in monthly installments via submissions of monthly invoices.
